- Building Progress Updates:
 - Glass panels were added to doors.
 - We're going to get an awning (wood frame canopy with steel roof) on the entrance.
 - Steve will find out this week when we are able to get in and paint.
 - Custom Ice is installing the low-e ceiling supports (no fabric yet).
 - We provided approximately 50 hours of labor towards the back up pump.
 - The cure period for the concrete will be done Friday. We're not flat yet; the concrete will be wet sanded to achieve a more level surface. To be discussed with Custom Ice.
 - The chiller should be delivered tomorrow! (might be delayed because of weather).
 - Electrical wiring work over the ice is done. Camera wire and internet wires will be installed Tuesdays. Detection system will be installed Wednesday.
 - After sanding, we can get started on stairs and walkways. We're not sure exactly when that will be, but that will require volunteer labor.
 - Electric: We have 2 out of 3 poles. There is damage to our drainage pipe, which will need to be addressed with DLC. Steve filed a claim with DLC robots.
 - o Still need:
 - Asphalt drive and gravel parking.
 - Planting of bushes
 - Dumpster enclosure
 - Handicap parking signs/asphalt painting
 - Bike rack installation.
 - There is a minor cost increase in plumbing and windows.
 - There was a minor decrease in painting.
 - There was a major increase in Asphalt. The previous bid for the job was over a year ago (\$20,250).
- GNCC:
 - We need to get something in the GNCC and USCA newsletters about our opening!
- Promissory Note:
 - o The verbiage of the note was sent to all board members.
- Motion to accept promissory note #1 as it is written, with Marie and Steve as the loaners and the club as borrowers: Turner/Sterling; 10 yes, 2 abstention (Marie and Steve).
- Brian to order paint: total cost: \$1500.00.

- Motion to approve Brian to use up to \$1500 to buy paint for the ice: Buffington/Roberts; carried unanimously.

- Fire detection and intrusion alarm system: Steve signed the contracts for the detection system with Telephonics. 50% + tax is due at \$1493.19 for intrusion and \$5773.83 for fire (part of construction budget).
- Tap Club: We would like to make a donation of \$300 for the use of their water when curing the concrete. Motion to pay a donation check to the tap club for \$300: Buffington/Roberts; carried unanimously.
- Motion to reimburse Daphne for \$835.40 for paint and supplies, Neill \$871.20 for plaques for donations, Doug \$342.24 for plastic sheeting, and Len \$271.25 for Moving Rocks for a total of \$2320.09 to be reimbursed: Roberts/Drombosky; carried unanimously.
